Antiqued

Creates the look of beams used in warehouses and structures built in the 1900's. The surface shows the worn faces of years of exposure giving as sense of establishment.

- Drawknife corners
- Heavy brushing of surface
- Smoother distressed look

Pit Sawn

The pit sawn process dates back hundreds of years displaying random saw marks and irregularities created from a long two-handled saw. Two men, one standing above the timber and the other below in the "Pit" worked together to cut the length of the log. This technique provides a unique and authentic texture full of appeal and character.

- Drawknife corners
- Brushed Surface
- Random distressing

Rough Hand Cut

Experience the era of timbers produced in the 1800's. Prior to the use of saws, timbers were laboriously cut by hand utilizing tools such as the Broad Ax, Adz, and Drawknife. This hand hewn texture provides a timeless aesthetic that reminds us of the time when our relationship with nature was more "hands on". The signature score marks and uneven, but blended appearance of our rough hand cut surface is a popular choice for *Old World* character.
